The Auxiliary to Harrisburg Chapter, Pennsylvania Society of Professional Engineers offers grants of up to \$2,000.00.

Specified for enrollment and attendance at an ABET accredited engineering school. Scholarships are one time only grants issued for freshmen attending their first semester in the fall of 2008.

Instructions for students completing the scholarship application:

1. Complete the Scholarship Application by answering all the questions.
1. Include a certified copy of your high school transcript indicating your courses for the first semester of the 12th grade.
2. Include your SAT, ACT or PAA scores on your transcript; attach a copy of the official test report.
3. Have your Guidance Counselor include a description of the curriculum and grading system used, and indicate on the transcript those courses in progress for the first semester of the 12th grade. Clearly indicate on the transcript all courses that are included in the high school "honors" or "advanced placement" programs, any courses completed from a college or university curriculum for which high school credit is earned, and credits earned from a special industry program.
4. Have your Guidance Counselor or Principal complete the appropriate portion of application.
5. Return the application to the Auxiliary Scholarship Chairperson no later than **March 15, 2008**:

- o Student essay
